The fish pick-up will be held at the Somerset NRCS office at 109 East Gay Street in Somerset.
Note: we do not have the ability to hold fish for later pick up.

You MUST bring enough containers , unscented poly liners (trash bags) and water to transport your fish.
The bags are necessary to hold oxygen to keep the fish alive during transport. If you do not bring containers, bags, and pond water your order will be refunded. NO buckets, boxes, bags or extra water will be available.

A general rule of thumb is 1 container per 100 small fish, 1 container per 1,000 minnows, and 1 container per 4-5 large fish. 5 gallon buckets or plastic totes work well. Please bring twine or string to close the bags. Each bucket or tote should be about 1/3 full of your pond water.
