

Election Notice

The Ohio Soil and Water Conservation Commission will cause an election of Supervisors of the Perry Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) to be held in accordance with Chapter 940 of the Ohio Revised Code. Individuals who own or occupy land within the Perry Soil and Water Conservation District and are 18 years of age or older may vote for Supervisor.

There are three ways an eligible voter can cast a ballot:

- 1.) At the SWCD office, 212 S. Main Street, Lower Level, New Lexington, OH 43764, from 8 a.m. Thursday, September 29, 2022 until 4 p.m. Friday, October 28, 2022 during normal business hours ; or
- 2.) At the Glenford Fort Preserve Fall Hike, which will take place at 11995 St. Rt. 757, Glenford, OH 43739 on Sunday, October 1, 2022 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.; or
- 4.) Voting absentee from Thursday, September 29, 2022 until Friday, October 28, 2022, by requesting the ballot application and election ballot from the SWCD office at the following address 212 S. Main Street, Lower Level, New Lexington, OH 43764, or by calling 740-743-1325 or by email at penny.cox@oh.nacdnet.net. Absentee ballots must be received by the SWCD office by no later than 4 p.m. on Friday, October 28, 2022.

One Supervisor will be elected to a three-year term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2025.
